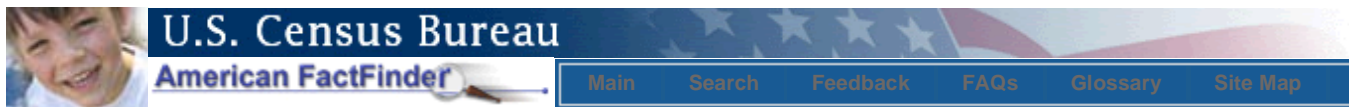


Appendix N

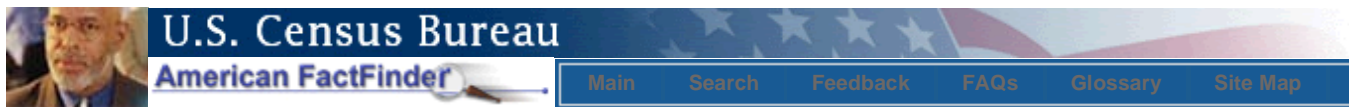
